Activity: Help our friends get to the telephone. (Warning: Someone forgot to charge the cell phone)

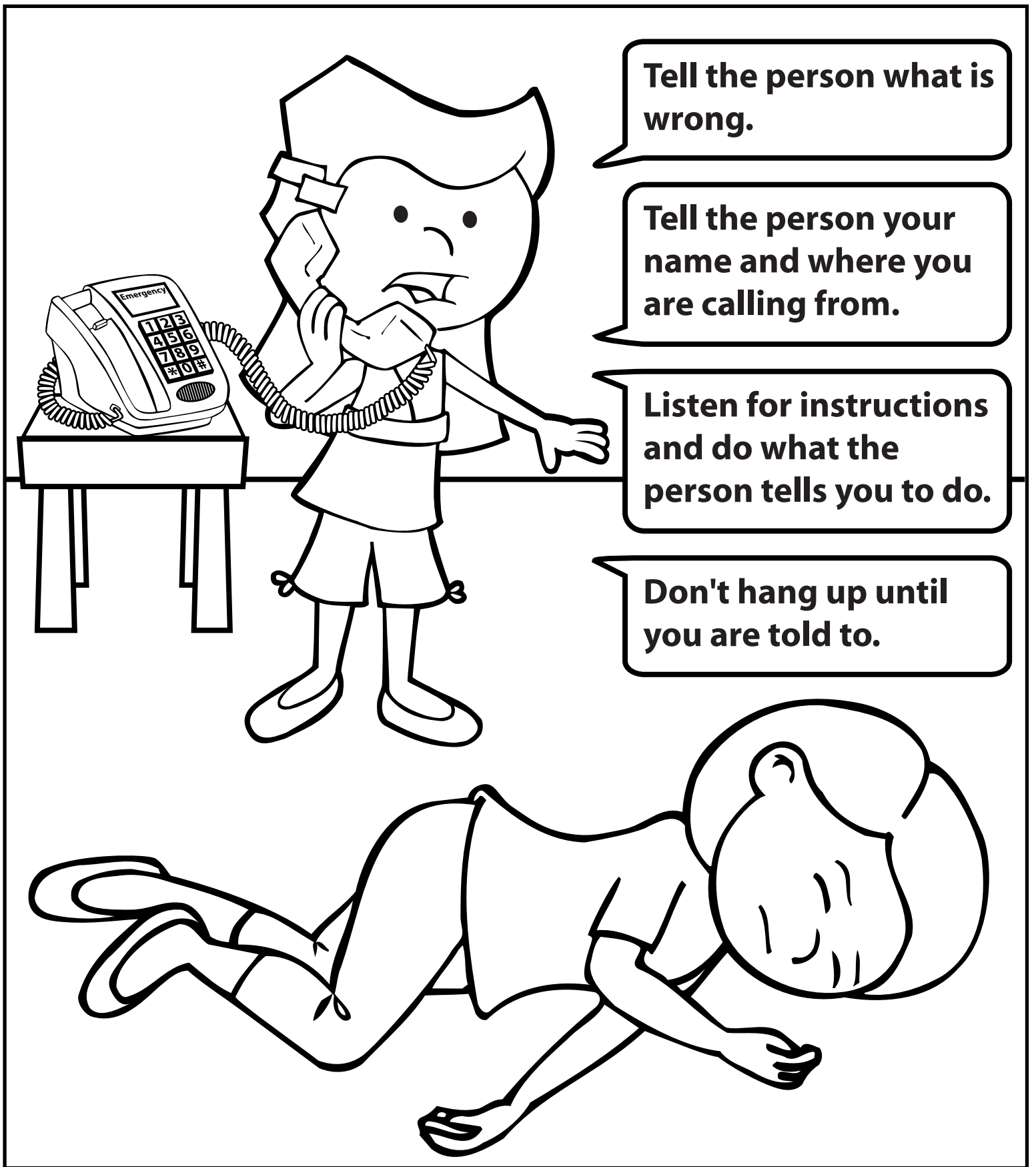


DJ asked, "Can anyone think of something we can use as an example?"

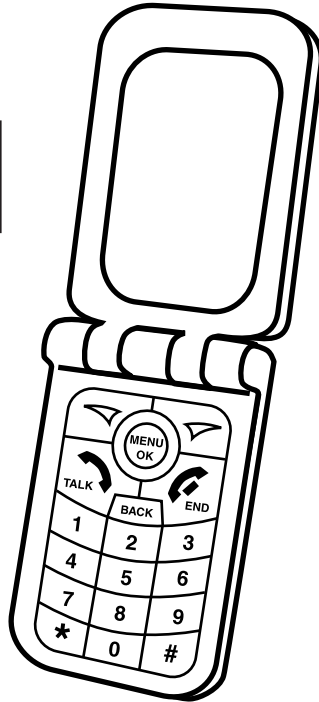
After an adult has shown you how to use the different telephones in your home while they are off or unplugged, draw a star in the box.
